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Registration Policy

1. Introduction

The practice boundary has been reduced effective from June 2019:

2. Registration of New Patients

The practice will only be registering new patients within the new boundary area.

3. Patients in the Old Boundary

Patients registered with the practice in the old boundary area will not be affected by the change.

Patients already registered will remain registered with the practice and will still be entitled to home visits.

If a patient registered with the practice in the old boundary area should have a new household member live with them – this new patient can be registered with the practice and have the same care as the household including home visits.

4. Out of Area Patients (OOA)

There may be the potential to register as an OOA patient if you are currently registered with the practice but move out of the practice boundary.

This is a clinical decision made by the partnership as this may have an impact on your care.

If you are accepted as an OOA patient this will mean that you are not entitled to home visits.

The Partners review all OOA patients on a regular basis to ensure that remaining as an OOA patient is in your best interest and that you are getting the best possible care.
