Would you be interested in taking part in the HOPE-e research study of a tablet treatment for hand pain being carried out by the University of Oxford and Charing Cross Hospital?

We are recruiting up to 90 women to take part in a research study of a drug treatment for hand pain.

If eligible to take part you would receive either:

A tablet containing estrogen and bazedoxifene once daily for 6 months
OR

Placebo (inactive tablet) once daily for 6 months
