- Pregnant women
- Adults in clinical risk groups
- All frontline health & social care workers
- Adults aged 65 years and over

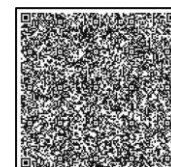
Patient Participation Group (PPG)

CQC Visit Update

Following our CQC inspection on 30 April 2026, we have been working to implement the changes identified following the visit and subsequent report.

We are pleased to share the following updates:

- Emergency equipment for both adults and paediatrics is now being held on site to ensure it is readily available if required.
- We have implemented a new training process for all staff to ensure that mandatory and required training remains up to date and is monitored regularly.
- A new process has been introduced to ensure that timely updates relating to Estates and Facilities are received from the Hospital of St John & St Elizabeth.

These changes form part of our ongoing commitment to maintaining high standards of safety, governance and quality, and to ensuring that we continue to learn and improve following external inspection.
